

## **7.0 DEFINITIONS**

### **ASSIGNED RESOURCES:**

Resources checked-in and assigned work tasks on an incident.

### **AVAILABLE RESOURCES:**

Resources assigned to an incident and available for assignment.

### **BRANCH DIRECTOR:**

An individual who is responsible for the implementation of a portion of the Incident Action Plan. The Branch Director reports to the Operations Section Chief when that position is filled or directly to the Incident Commander when the Operations Section Chief is not filled.

### **CHECK-IN RECORDER:**

An individual located at the Support Control Center that checks in all resources and personnel who will be assisting with the incident.

### **EMERGENCY OPERATIONS CENTER: (EOC)**

The centralized command and coordination center for use during a disaster or major emergency. The Emergency Operations Center is located at the County Government Center in SLO.

### **GROUP SUPERVISOR:**

An individual who is responsible for the implementation of an assigned portion of the Incident Action Plan. The Group Supervisor reports to the Branch Director.

### **INCIDENT ACTION PLAN: (IAP)**

Is initially prepared at the first planning meeting, and contains general objectives reflecting the overall incident strategy, and specific action plans for the next operational period. When complete, the Incident Action Plan will have a number of attachments.

### **INCIDENT BASE: (IB)**

That location at which the primary logistics functions are coordinated and administered. The Incident Command Post may be located with the Incident Base.

### **INCIDENT COMMAND POST: (ICP)**

That location at which the primary command functions are executed. The Incident Command Post will be located at the CAL FIRE/SLO County Fire Station #33.

### **INCIDENT COMMANDER: (IC)**

An individual whom has responsibility for overall command including coordination and management of incident activities, and development, implementation, and review of strategic decisions.

**OPERATIONAL PERIOD:**

The period of time scheduled for execution of a given set of operation actions as specified in the Incident Action Plan.

**PLANNING MEETING:**

A meeting, held as needed throughout the duration of the incident, to select specific strategies and tactics for incident control operations and for service and support planning.

**SUPPORT CONTROL CENTER: (SCC)**

The location where HRCSD and HROA employees and civilian volunteers will report to and be assigned tasks. The Support Control Center will be located at the HRCSD Office.

**TEAM LEADER: (TL)**

An individual who is responsible for implementation of an assigned portion of the Incident Action Plan. The Team Leader reports to a Group Supervisor.

**UNIFIED COMMAND: (UC)**

A team effort that allows all agencies with jurisdictional responsibilities for an incident to participate in the management of that incident, by developing and implementing a common set of incident objectives and strategies documented in an Incident Action Plan.
