Emergency Pool Rules **Revised June 8, 2021**

These Emergency Pool Rules are established to address safety and sanitation procedures for the two (2) Heritage Ranch Owners Association (HROA) Pools with regards to opening the pools for the 2021 summer season and enacting the current COVID-19 requirements per the County of San Luis Obispo. These Emergency Pool Rules are in addition to the existing rules already set forth in the HROA Membership Handbook, Section 5.04 Swimming Pools, and may supersede some existing rules where they pertain to maintaining physical distancing in the pool areas and County Public Health mandates.

Effective Date: June 9, 2021

- The Heritage Park pool hours of operation will be Wednesday – Sunday each week, and as follows:
 - 10:00 to 11:00 am – Lap Swim ONLY
 - 11:00 am to 8:00 pm – Open Swim hours
 - Available at full capacity (65 ppl)
- The Equestrian Park pool hours will be Wednesday – Sunday each week, and as follows:
 - 12:00 Noon to 6:00 pm
 - Available at full capacity (25 people)
- As stated above, dedicated lap swim will continue to be from 10:00 to 11:00 am at the Heritage Park Pool, and lap swimmers must exit the pool area to re-enter at 11:00 am if there are already members waiting in line to get into the pool area for regular day use.
- As soon as each of the pool areas reaches capacity, the signage indicating that the pool area is full will be visibly installed by the Pool Attendants next to the pool area entrance gate.
- The Heritage Park pool deck will have a maximum of two (2) pool lounge chairs placed every 6' to encourage the recommended social distancing. It is encouraged that these groupings of pool lounge chairs are to remain 6' apart whenever possible during open pool hours.
- Members may bring guests and family members to the pool, as long as each family or group is no more than (10) ppl.
- For HROA residents that are 14 years of age or older and are not old enough to have a Member card and/or a Driver's License, a parents' name and telephone contact number is required upon entry to the pool area so that the Pool Attendants can verify identity and residency with the parent(s) if necessary.
- Parties are encouraged to remain in their pool deck space when not in the pool or utilizing the pool restroom facilities.
- All members' personal items are encouraged to be kept inside their space on the pool deck.
- Pool toys of any kind are not allowed in the pool area. Goggles, masks, life jackets, swim floating devices, and water wings for non-swimmers are allowed.
- No additional chairs or coolers are permitted to be bought into the pool area from any outside area, including chairs brought by members from their homes. Small, personal size bags containing items like sunscreen and a towel are allowed.

- The Pool Attendants reserve the right to inform a member if they are bringing too many personal items into the pool area to where the extent of these items will prohibit additional members from using the pool deck.
- At the Heritage Park pool, members will request a red restroom pass from a Pool Attendant in order to return to the pool area after using the pool restroom. The Pool Attendant will then allow the parties to return to the pool area using the Exit gate.
- It is encouraged that all members wear face masks when on the pool deck area, and not in the water.
- Pool Attendants will sanitize all pool loungers and spaces that have been vacated by members before the next members' use.
- Anyone entering the pool area must sanitize their hands with Association-provided hand sanitizer.
- Pool restroom surfaces, hand railings, shower knobs and door handles will be sanitized by the Pool Attendants a minimum of every two (2) hours.
- Pool Attendants will wear face masks when within 6' of anyone in the pool area.
- Both the Heritage Park Pool and the Equestrian Park Pool will be open on the Monday of Memorial Day weekend, the Monday of 4th of July weekend, and the Monday of Labor Day weekend.
- Reusable drink containers with lids are allowed with water or non-sugar drinks. Non-disposable straws that come with the reusable drink container lid are also allowed. Styrofoam cups, disposable plastic straws and juice pockets are prohibited as these items can blow away, break apart and damage the pool equipment.
